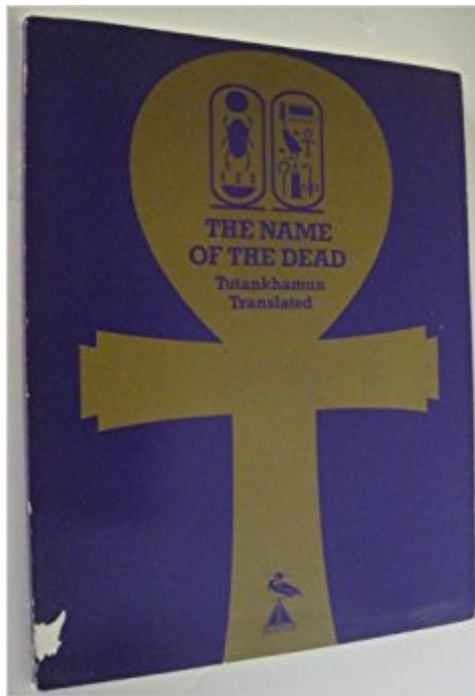


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The Name Of The Dead: Hieroglyphic Inscriptions Of The Treasures Of Tutankhamun Translated
