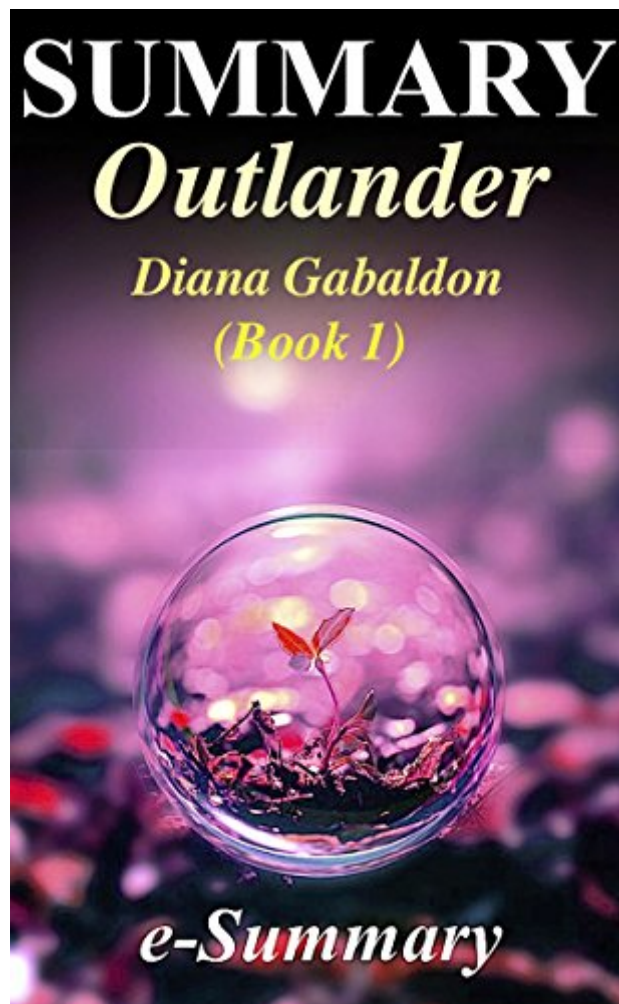


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## Synopsis

I have been watching the TV show Outlander on Starz, and am pretty much obsessed with it. I have read the entire series, and am now anxiously waiting for season two. The waiting is kind of getting to me, so I have been doing a lot of googling, and came across this summary of Dragonfly In Amber. This book was free to download with my Kindle Unlimited subscription, which was an awesome plus. I have been reading a lot of summary & analysis' on anything related to Outlander and the book series, and this is one of the better ones I have come across. The information was straight forward and easy to understand, and it was also short and to the point. I will be looking for more reviews by e-Summary on any of Diana Gabaldon's other books.

I don't know who the author of this summary was, but I question if they read the book. The spelling and grammar was horrible and they got the characters mixed up. I wanted to get out my red pen and make corrections as I read. For example they talk about how Jamie paid Claire a compliment and then in the next paragraph says that they had a lot in common like cooking and pregnancy. It obviously refers to Jenny, but it's Jaime's name that is used. Another example is that she rides with Dougal looking for Jamie when it was Murtagh. and then they say that Dougal tells Jamie that Jamie is to be hung. Huh? There are key plot points that are either totally ignored or glossed over - for example the details of Claire's rescue from Randall or Jamie's escape from Wentworth Prison. Frankly, I have seen better summaries written by my high school students! A better summary can be found in the Outlandish Companion written by the author herself.

This is the most easy to understand and perfectly written summary version of the Outlander I've ever read. I've tried to read a summarize version of this novel before but I didn't like it because it lacked the essence of the original version but this book is different. It is indeed an amazing summary book to read and I highly recommend it; kudos to the author.

Reading this book was just a beautiful, wonderful journey. I can't quite describe my feelings after finishing. Blissfully content at having a happy ending for once, glad for no cliffhanger. The characters are just so real and flawed but that just makes me love them, and their romance, even

more. But still yearning for more Jamie and Claire.

Not really a good summary for Outlander stories. I think there are many details and important scenes that were not emphasized well. I am not that disappointed since it was a free book. The price is good for its worth. Just need deeper thoughts and book will be ok.

I have spent most of my life avoiding "romance" books, since I consider them to be a complete waste of time. They actually suck intelligence out of your brain as you read them. That being said, I wholeheartedly enjoyed this book. I don't believe that the books should be classified as "romance," because the characters are too realistic and the historical details are too enjoyable. Thank you to the author for sharing this book.

I thought the information in this summary did not come anywhere close in describing the excitement I felt in reading the book. The summary was pretty boring and should have been proof read for grammatical errors prior to publishing. I hope that future readers of The Outlander do not read this summary first, as it is poorly written and may prevent new readers from reading The Outlander series.
