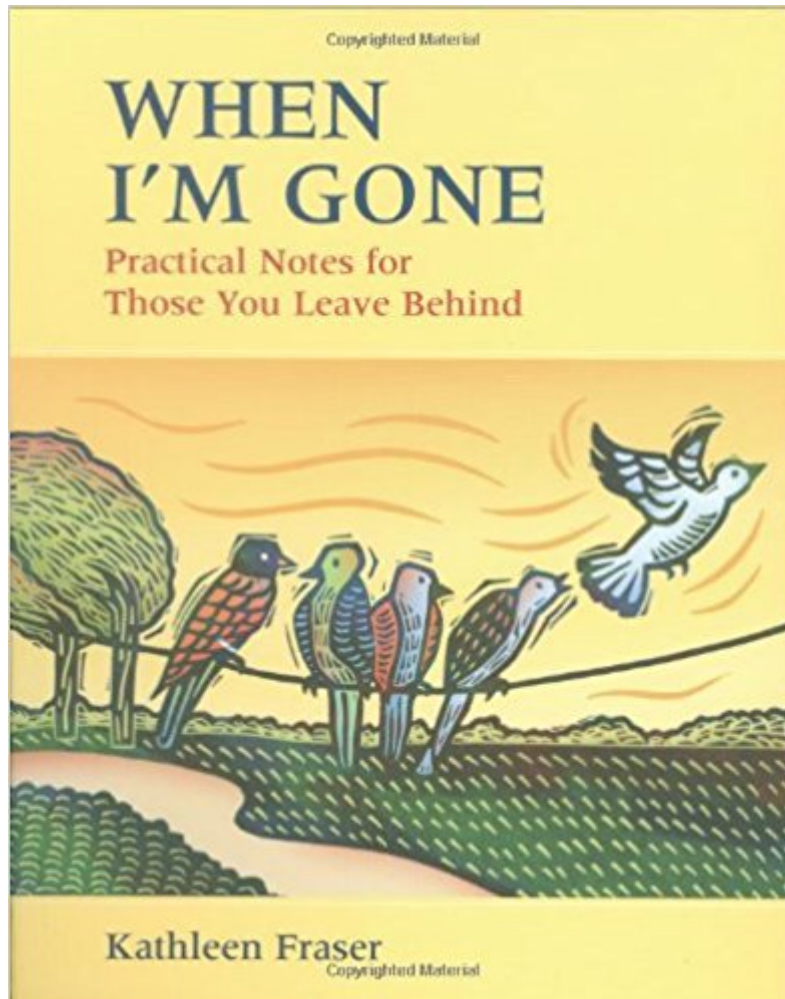

It seems to me that this book's main purpose is to have you think about what you need to communicate. Okay, so maybe loose-leaf would have been better. Get a loose-leaf binder and tie it to this book so you have room for all that does not fit. The point is that the book has you think about the topic. That is its main benefit. If it does not cover all you need, add to it; staple in notes and extra pages; don't pan the author's attempt to help people get organized!

Definitely a good book to use. It's over 100 pages, but well worth the price if you can get your parents/yourself to complete it. Try one chapter at a time, otherwise it could seem overwhelming. The author should consider an electronic format, if not already available with fill & print pages.

This is a disappointing book - not what I expected at all. I am an attorney and some of the legal advice in here is wrong. Every state is different when it comes to estates and probate and if you buy this book, do not rely on anything legal without checking with an estate attorney.
