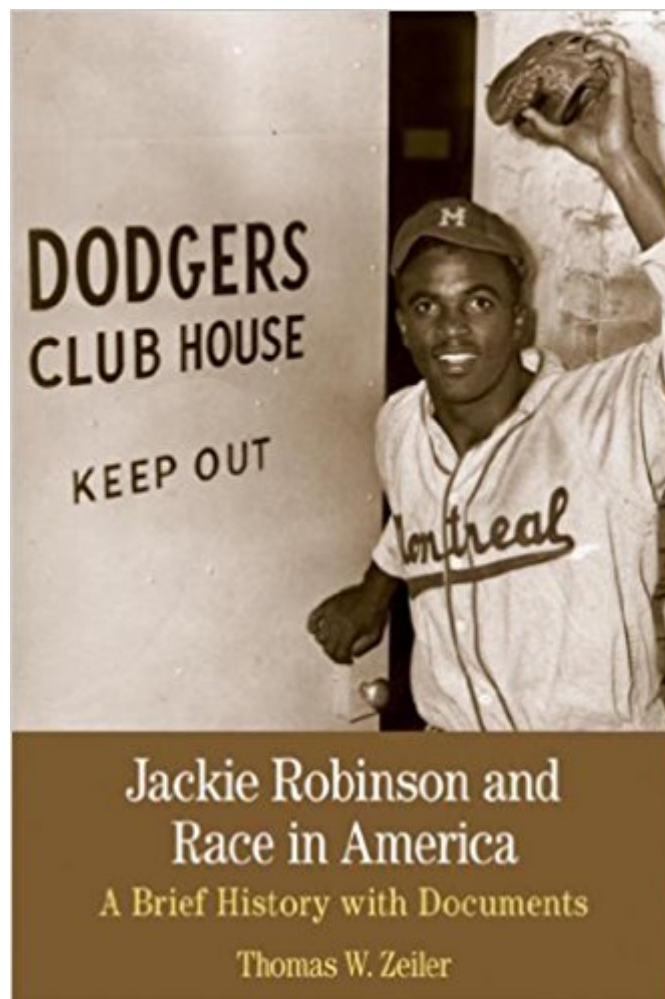


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Jackie Robinson And Race In America: A Brief History With Documents (Bedford Series In History And Culture)
